


Analysis Report of Faculty Feedback on Syllabus 2024-2025




Q1. The syllabus has been revised as per NCTE guidelines 2014 and NEP-2020 18 responses




Q2. The syllabus is drafted to fulfill teacher education demands.




Q3. The syllabus is designed to provide opportunities to student teachers to get ideas about emerging ideas and domains.




Q4. Course objectives for each paper are all well defined.








Q7. Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practicals (Field based activities). 18 responses




Q 9. Practicum given in each paper are adequate and appropriate.




Q10. I am satisfied with the semester pattern for the B.Ed course.




Q 11. Books prescribed in syllabus are adequate




Q 12. There is a need to update the syllabus.




Q 13. Activities suggested for internship needs to be re-framed.




Q 14. EPC courses are very useful.

Following Suggestions were given by the Faculty:

- > "Ethics and professionalism in teaching" should be added and taught

Faculty expressed the following difficulties faced with regard to the Lab Schools during Internship

- > Schools are not available for a long period for internship activity
- ➤ Schools uses trainee students for classroom engagement, hence it effects other activities
- ➤ Insufficient infrastructure and physical facilities for performing extracurricular activities.
- ➤ Inadequate facilities for interns provided by the school
- No cooperation from school
- ➤ Some schools have few number of students in their classes
- > Regarding school permission for long duration, Students attendance,
- Due to poor infrastructure of schools, pupil teachers and supervisor face difficulties
- > Time allotted by school is insufficient
- > School academic planning and internship duration difficult to match as school exams and practice lessons overlap
- > Schedule of the school during their exams hinders internship planning.

- Lack of facilities, non-availability of room for students
- > Time period of internship
- > Time for internship should not fall during school examination duration, as it becomes difficult to fulfill all the activities of Internship.
- ➤ Non-cooperation from some schools for conducting activities

1	Syllabus Transaction- Semester Pattern & Teacher's Training mismatch	It was discussed in the staff meeting that regarding difficulties in syllabus transaction will be communicated to the University through BOS members.		
2	Internship activities need to be re-framed	It was decided to plan for the field based activities which are needed to be added so that BOS members from the college will take the matter to university for amendment.		
3	Semester Pattern & Duration of Internship	It was decided that it will be communicated to the university through BOS regarding difficulties faced due semester pattern for the training course.		
4	Facilities at Lab Schools during Internship	As many of the schools are very cooperative & ever ready to provide required facilities, incase if at any school some difficulties arises the Mentor should try to convince the school authorities for the arrangements.		
5	Overlapping of Internship & School Activities	It was discussed and finalised that college will collect the annual plan of the Lab schools and provide it to the concerned Mentor so that Internship can be planned accordingly in coordination with School H.Ms.
